
## Play with me, will you?


Neo-Whimsy, Doodle-Dynamism, Clashcore Aesthetics, Handcrafted Relatability, Shockplay Storytelling














### **Chronos-e-Khwaab**

### A Love Letter in Pixels


Retro-Futurism, Pixelcore, Low-Poly Aesthetics, Analog Anxiety, Bitverse Renaissance


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
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












## Clean your room!




## Mama, I'm Spiralling


Motion Made Visual, Hypnotic Flow, Fibonacci Sequence, Whirlpool Whiplash, Cyclic Influence

Design trends are increasingly embracing the dynamic and immersive power of motion, translating it into static mediums. 














